Individual Horse Lease Fees:

- Lessee is responsible for board and maintenance costs (i.e. farrier, routine vet care, tooth floating, worming, any meds/ supplements). Some horses will require mortality/ major medical insurance
- Lease term will be determined on an individual basis
- Half lease is 1/2 of full lease fees

Farm Show Pricing:

Farm Horse Show Lease:

• \$60 per day

Transport of horses:

- \$2.00 per mile (one way), \$50 minimum *subject to change based on fuel prices*
- Out of state travel will be quoted on a per trip basis

Coaching:

- \$60 per day, based on one rider/ one horse.
 - Riders on additional horses and divisions, add \$30 for extra trainer time (exceptions will be made for farm training purposes)
- *Note* Trainers are only expected to be ringside for beginner flat classes

Coach's Expenses:

 Divided up between all participants
*Please make sure your coach is fed and hydrated throughout show day, as she is needed in the arenas

Training Rides:

- \$35 per ride
- Horses in full training are exempt from additional fee

Coach Showing Horse:

• \$35 per class. 3+ classes: \$30 per class

Day Care Fees:

- Full: \$65 (feed, water, clean stall, groom, tack up)
- Basic: \$45 (feed, water, clean stall)
- Partial: \$30 (feed, water)

Load/ Set up & Take Down/ Unload:

- \$30 to show, \$30 to return (non-day shows)
- \$15 to show and \$15 to return (day show)
- *There is a LOT of work to prepare, load tack and horses, unpack and set up, as well as take down, reload and unload horses/ gear and clean up. This is especially true after the show when it is late and EVERYONE is tired! If the trainer has to do all or most of the work, it is just too much work and not worth the money!
- It is the trainer's discretion to determine the help given at any "point". As much as \$15 will be charged for each load/ unload period.

Wrapping:

- \$15 all 4; \$20 for all 4 w/ farm wraps.
- \$5 participant wraps w/ farm wraps

Mane Pulling:

• \$20 per 30-minute intervals

Clipping:

- Ears: \$20
- Full Head and Lower Legs: \$40
- Full Body: \$150 (horse) or \$125 (pony)
- Trace Clip: \$100 (horse) or \$75 (pony)

Groom Horse:

• \$10, plus tack up: \$15

Lunge Horse:

• \$25 (30 minutes), \$10 if non trainer

Meds:

• Farm meds will be charged as they are at the farm on owned or leased horses

Medications:
